TASTE PROFILE

A deep bright red cherry colour. The wine's thick legs come to tint the glass, which gives an idea of its density. On the nose, the wine is intense and elegant, with hints of black wild fruit, spices, balsamics and roasted notes, milk coffee, all wrapped in a soft touch of fine wood. The palate is meaty, juicy, creamy, with soft tannins, very fruity with hints of black liquorice. It is long and pleasant, with great balance. To drink and enjoy now, or save for the next 5 years or longer

VINEYARD

The grapes come from the plot "El Pitorral". The culture system per vertical cordon reduces plant vigor, achieving a lower yield per vine. Clayey-chalky soil.

STYLE OF VINTAGE

There was adequate rain over the winter period in Utiel-Requena which came as a relief after the extremely dry conditions of 2014. This was followed by particularly high temperatures in both spring and summer – May temperatures hit 40°C at times. A small amount of the crop was lost due to hail storms in May, July and September in the northeast and centre of the region. Other areas to the north-west and west experienced milder and more stable weather and as a result some of the best "exceptional" fruit was harvested in these areas.

WINEMAKING & AGING

The fermentation with cold maceration for 3 weeks. Malolactic fermentation in second-use oak barrels from central France (Boutes, Cadus and Saury), fine-grained and lightly toasted. Aged for 14 months in second use barrels, same as above.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Amazing with Sushi, or even Noodle bowls (like Pho!). More simply try it with a watermelon snowcone or a sunny day!
